2. Scholarships will be awarded to students proceeding from grade 12 to any academic, vocational, or technical institution. Post-secondary students may also apply. *Repeat scholarships may be awarded.*
3. Candidates must complete the application in full and have an overall C or better grade average in the semester immediately preceding the deadline.
4. The following must accompany the application:
 - (a) A letter from a member in the community, or school official, written on behalf of the applicant, with regard to your leadership qualities, community activities and character.
 - (b) A copy of your current year 1st and 2nd semester marks.
5. Confirmation of the scholarship will be by way of a letter from the BIGC Scholarship Committee presented at the successful applicant's graduation ceremony. The scholarship will be funded by the Bowen Island Community Foundation, upon the successful applicant confirming their registration, complete with student enrollment number, in a post-secondary academic institution or trade school.
6. Scholarships may be claimed up to two (2) years after graduation, or in special circumstances, where a letter request is made to and approved by the BIGC Scholarship/Management Committee up to three (3) years after graduation.
7. The selection of a scholarship winner is solely the responsibility of the BIGC Scholarship/Management Committee. All applications shall remain the property of the Committee.
